

Educational Leadership Program Guidelines

Major: Sport Management (KSOCSCI BS - SPM)

These guidelines summarize the requirements for a Bachelor of Science for students following the 2025-2026 requirements.

The Sport Management major prepares students for employment in the marketing, promotion, and/or management of sport-related enterprises. Such areas can include community, college/university, professional and corporate sport organizations.

Common Curriculum Requirements: The Common Curriculum requirements listed in the Academic Regulations of the University of Connecticut Undergraduate Catalog 2025-2026 include:

- **Topic of Inquiry (TOI) Requirements:** At least one course (3 credits) in each of the 6 different TOIs; 6 different subject areas; one laboratory science (TOI-6L); minimum of 21 TOI credits; TOI Focus area (3 courses in 1 TOI) or Theme (3 pre-determined courses)
- **Competency Requirements:** Two Writing (W) courses; two quantitative (Q course) courses; Second language through elementary level 2

SPM Related Requirements:

COMM 1100, ECON 1201, ECON 1202; MATH 1070Q, PSYC 1100; PSYC 1101 or PSYC 1103, PSYC 2600, SOCI 1001 or SOCI 1251; STAT 1000Q or STAT 1100Q.

SPM Cognate Electives: Students will select at least **15 credits (five 3-credit courses)** of advisor approved 2000-level or higher major related courses outside of Educational Leadership. Note: UNIV courses cannot count toward this requirement.

Earn at least 120 credits with a minimum total grade point average of 2.2. In order to reach 120 credits, students usually take at least 15 credits each semester.

***EDLR 3091 Enrollment (see below for options on completing)**

EDLR 3091 Internship - 6 cr. (after completion of EDLR 3310, 3090 and two additional Sport Management courses)

- By registering for EDLR 3091 for 6 credits during Summer Session 3 (complete 240 hours over approximately 12 weeks)
- By registering for EDLR 3091 for 3 credits over 2 concurrent semesters (complete 120 hours each semester). As an example, register for 3 credits of EDLR 3091 in Fall and 3 credits of EDLR 3091 in Spring or 3 credits in Summer and 3 credits in Fall.
- **NOTE:** Students registering for EDLR 3091 during Fall or Spring semesters CANNOT register for more than 4 additional courses for the semester enrolled in 3091.

**Required of all students not meeting the University requirements of three years of a single second language in high school.
